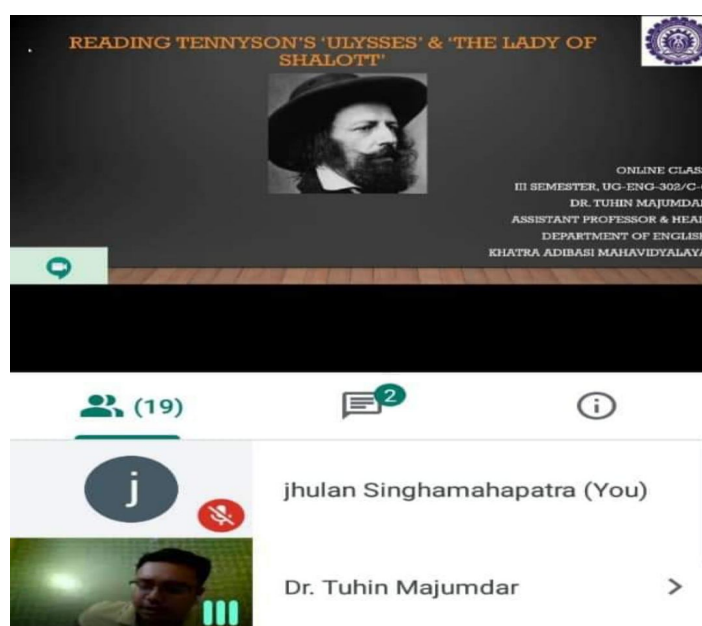


Image 1: Online classes during COVID-19

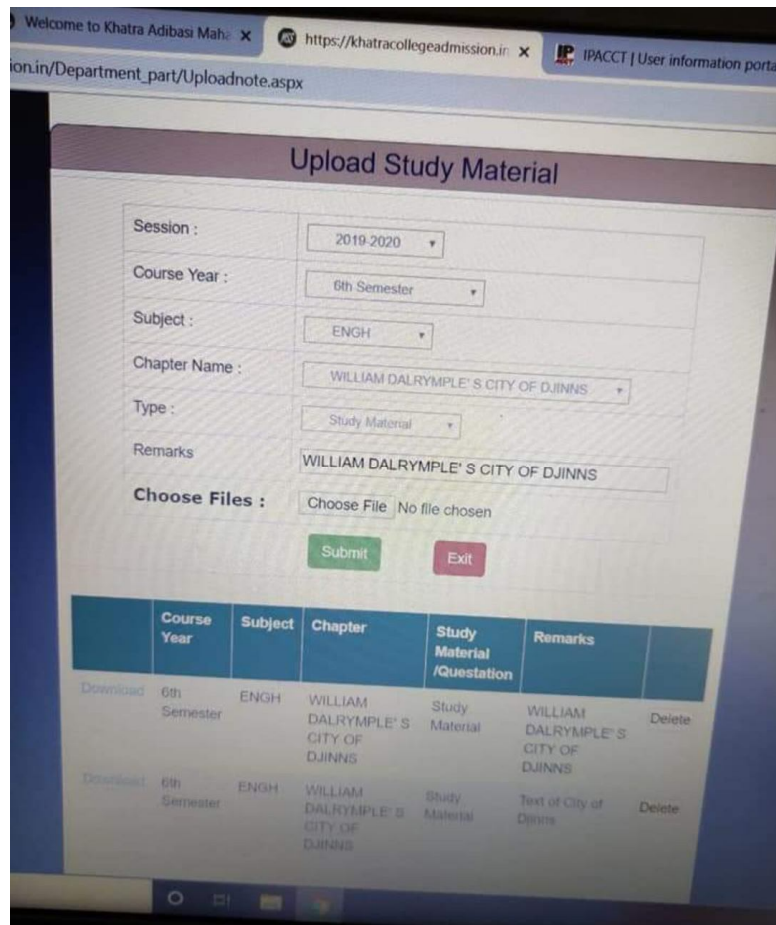


Image 2: Uploading Study Materials for students in cloud based college ERP

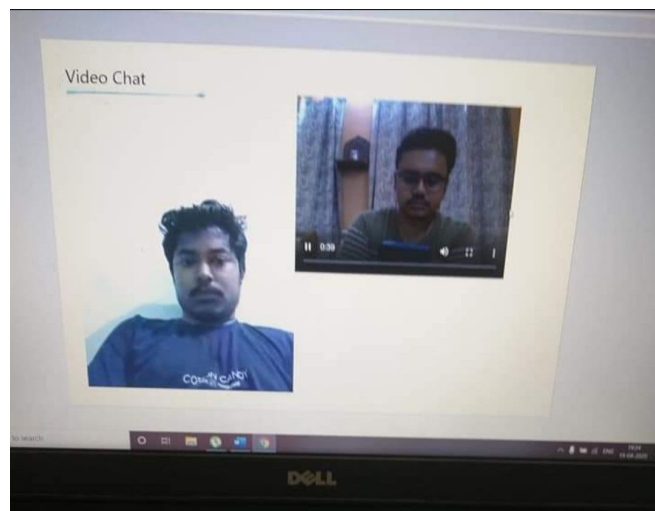


Image 3: Students interacting via college ERP

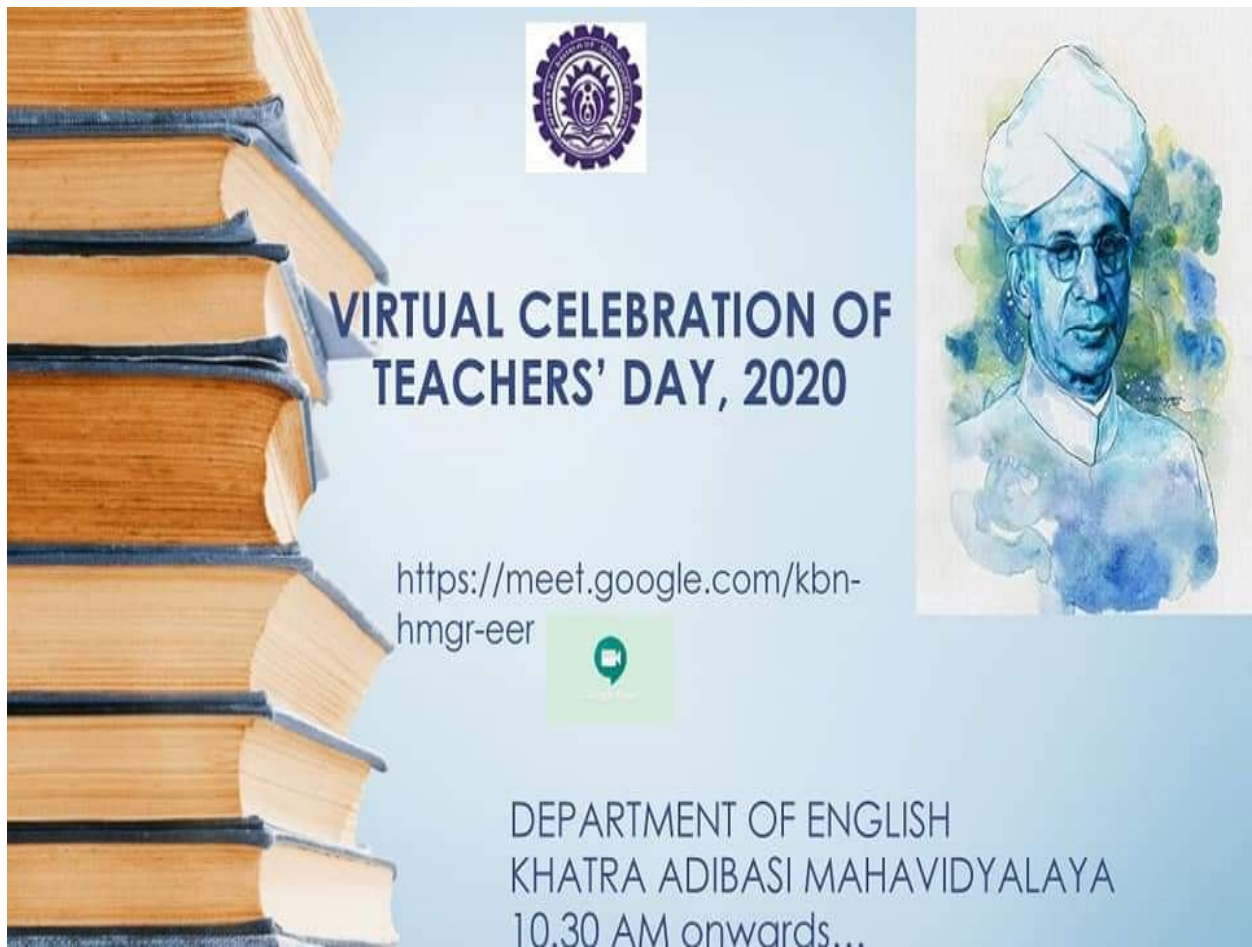


Image 5: Virtual Teachers Day Celebration, 2020

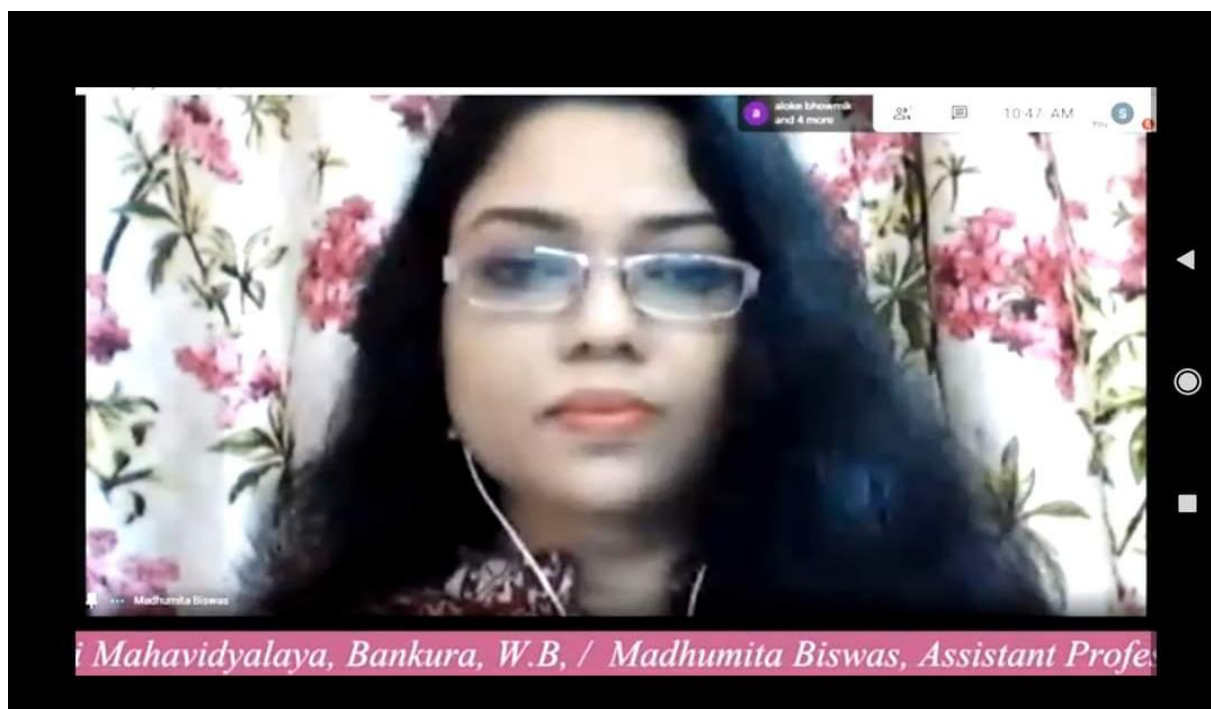

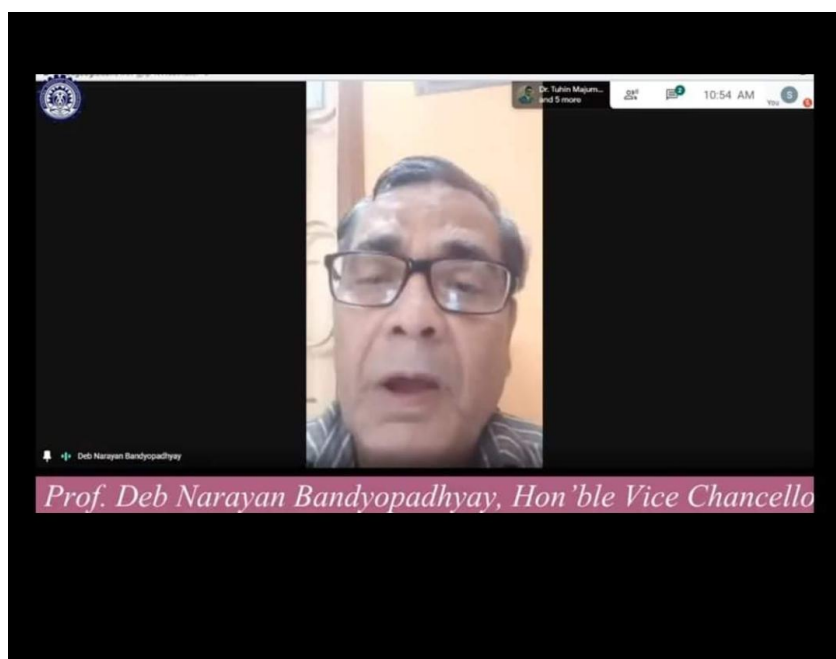

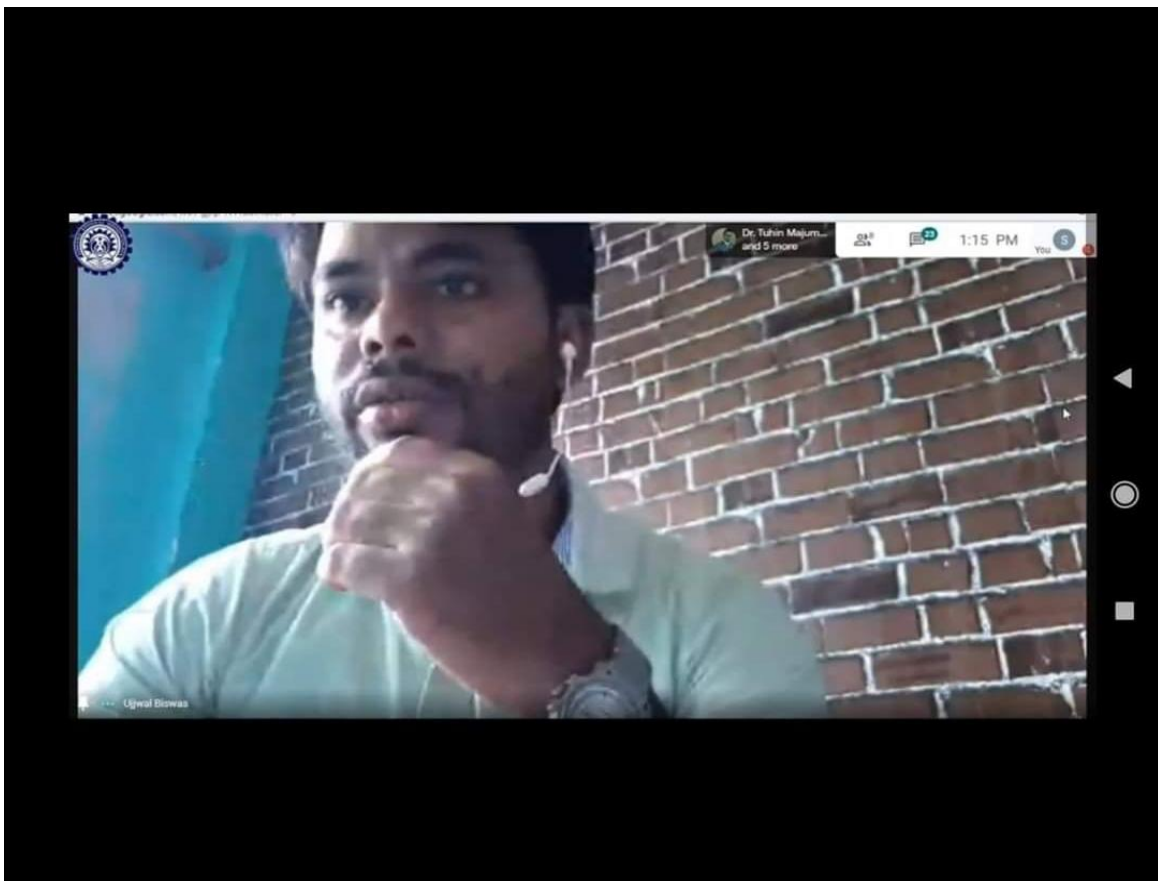
