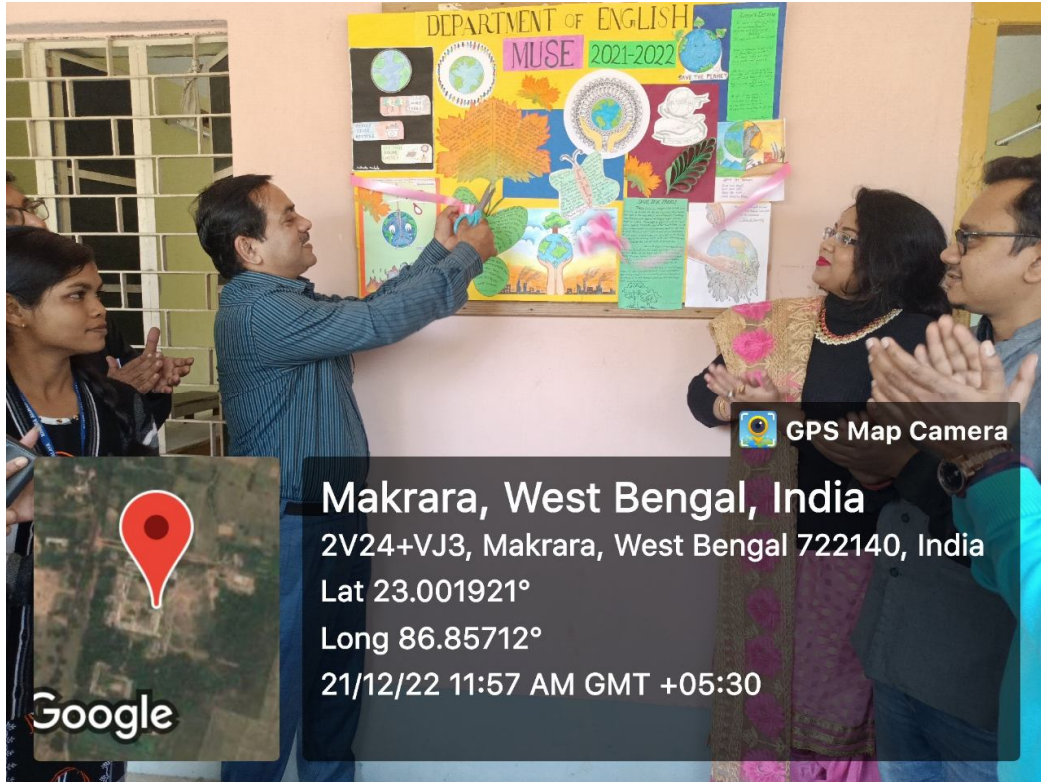


Image 2: Principal Sir inaugurating the Wall Magazine

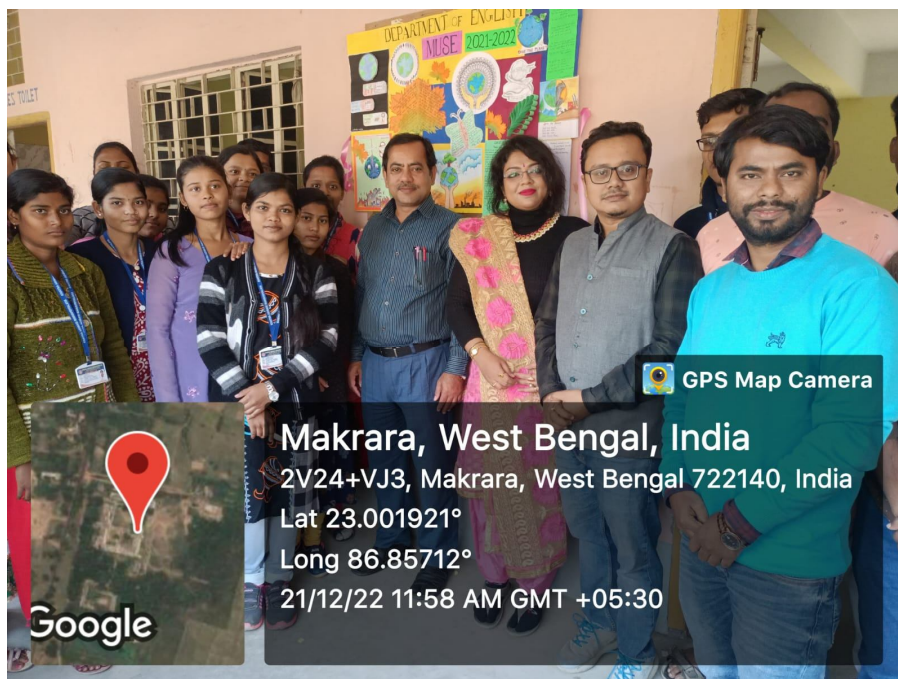


Image 3: Students with the Wall Magazine
