

Report

Every year World Consumer Rights Day is celebrated on 15th March across the globe to raise awareness of the consumers regarding their rights and needs. The Departments of Commerce, Economics and Political Science in collaboration with the NSS wing of the college under the aegis of IQAC, Khatra Adibasi Mahavidyalaya organized a One Day Institution Level Seminar to celebrate World Consumer Rights Day on 15.03.2023. The seminar began with the inaugural speech delivered by the Head of the Department of Commerce, Prof. Kalyan Kanti Dutta. He made the students aware about the significance of World Consumer Rights Day. Next, Dr Parthasarothi Hati, Teachers Council Secretary, Khatra Adibasi Mahavidyalaya and Dr. Arindam Chakrabarti, IQAC Coordinator, Khatra Adibasi Mahavidyalaya spoke on important issues related to World Consumer Rights Day. Dr. Kamalika Chakraborty, Head of the Department of Economics made a Power Point Presentation on the theme of World Consumer Rights Day 2023 i.e., 'Empowering Consumers Through Clean Energy Transitions' before the students and explained the relevance of this theme in today's world. 
