Resolution and Recommendation: The result indicates a high success rate, with 84.6% of the students qualifying in the 6th Semester Honours course. Out of 39 students, 33 successfully passed, while 6 did not qualify. This performance reflects the department's commitment to maintaining high academic standards and ensuring that a significant majority of students achieve their academic goals. For the six students who did not qualify, it was decided to advice them to rreview exam papers to identify specific areas where they struggled and then seek feedback from faculty members on topics or concepts that need more attention.
