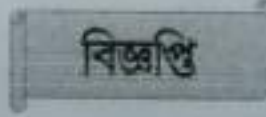

#### Participants:


