



Report

Every year World Consumer Rights Day is celebrated on 15th March across the globe to raise awareness of the consumers regarding their rights and needs. The Departments of Commerce, Economics and Political Science in collaboration with the NSS wing of the college under the aegis of IQAC, Khatra Adibasi Mahavidyalaya organized a One Day Institution Level Seminar to celebrate World Consumer Rights Day on 15.03.2023. The seminar began with the inaugural speech delivered by the Head of the Department of Commerce, Prof. Kalyan Kanti Dutta. He made the students aware about the significance of World Consumer Rights Day. Next, Dr Parthasarothi Hati, Teachers Council Secretary, Khatra Adibasi Mahavidyalaya and Dr. Arindam Chakrabarti, IQAC Coordinator, Khatra Adibasi Mahavidyalaya spoke on important issues related to World Consumer Rights Day. Dr. Kamalika Chakraborty, Head of the Department of Economics made a Power Point Presentation on the theme of World Consumer Rights Day 2023 i.e., 'Empowering Consumers Through Clean Energy Transitions' before the students and explained the relevance of this theme in today's world. Prof. Saiful Ansari, Head of the Department of Political Science made a Power Point Presentation on 'Consumer Protection: In the light of Law in India' in which he discussed about Consumer Protection Acts in India. At the end of both the presentations queries from the audience were answered by the speakers.

Objectives

The main objectives of this seminar were:

a) to draw the attention of the students to market malpractices, which undermine the rights of consumers and what more can be done to empower buyers

b) to help the students know about the various types of clean energy sources and their uses

c) to highlight the importance of transition of all economies to clean energy sources

d) to make the students aware about the Consumer Protection Acts which we can resort to in case our rights are undermined

The outcomes of this seminar were:

a) Students learnt about the significance of World Consumer Rights Day

b) They understood the benefits of switching over to clean energy sources in their daily life. They realised that transition to clean energy sources will help them to curtail their monthly energy bills as well contribute towards pollution free environment.

c) Students became aware of the various Consumer Protection Acts and how to take the help of law in case they encounter unfair trade practices.


Outcomes:


