ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The digital revolution in India marks a turning point in India's history, having a significant impact on economic, commercial, political and educational trajectories, thus making a pertinent contribution towards the dream of Viksit Bharat 2047. In fact, this sector is likely to grow at a faster rate than the traditional sectors such as agriculture and industry within the coming six years. Through this seminar we would like to bring to the forefront the versatile impact of digitalisation on India's economic growth, financial incentives, political governance and education system. The digital revolution in India has been instrumental in promoting financial inclusion (JAM Trinity), creating employment opportunities, enhancing productivity through automation and data analytics, making government services more accessible through e-governance facilities (Digital India, Digi Locker, Umang) and providing protection against cyberattacks. The digital revolution has played an equally pivotal role in the education sector by providing online access to education (SWAYAM, ePathshala, Diksha) and various educational applications. This seminar will throw a spotlight on all these issues. The objective of the seminar is to analyse the current trends in digital transformation in India and provide insights regarding the future of digitalisation in India. The seminar aims to promote further academic research on India's digital economy and provide a comprehensive understanding about India's digital drive, popularize inclusive digital education and assess India's role in the global digital platform. Risks associated with AI include algorithmic prejudice, excessive surveillance, job displacement and the spread of false information. Thus, responsible use of AI should be ensured through well-designed ethical, regulatory and pedagogical frameworks. The seminar will create a platform for the exchange of ideas and knowledge among academicians, researchers and students so that their collective will helps achieve the goal of Viksit Bharat through digitalisation of the economy. Our college is situated in an economically disadvantaged area in rural West Bengal. A large section of the students in this college are first-generation learners, and lack of digital infrastructure is one of the primary concerns of this area. In this context, very few national-level events on digital transformation and Viksit Bharat 2047 have taken place. By providing a common forum for discussion among academicians, educators, students and community members, the seminar aims to transform the theoretical propositions of Viksit Bharat 2047 into practical ways to achieve inclusive digital growth.
